Corporal Brett "The Butcher" Butcherson

Corporal Butcherson is a career agent with years of knowledge of the inner workings of B.E.E.F. Recruited directly after university, Butcherson advanced through several departments, showing a distinct aptitude for research and experimentation and a keen interest in the Bureau's Fractalation departments. His investigation into the biological effects of fractalation exposure resulted in the mutation and/or deaths of a number of lab animals; the resulting data gathered was promising and has been collated in File R5C6E8. Agents are advised to consult the relevant file before interaction with Butcherson, as we do not know what parts of his research he may be using to accelerate the Event.

It is also possible—but unconfirmed—that Butcherson himself has mutated due to repeated exposure to concentrated fractalation energies. He keeps with him a six-legged raccoon, designation Tripp. This creature is clearly Extranormal in nature and agents are advised to treat it with the same caution they would treat Butcherson. The continued presence of such a creature may be further evidence of his awareness of the Event.

Butcherson was transferred from the Department of Computational Analysis of Lissajous Figures after an incident resulting in the non-fatal injury of a senior director. Thorough investigation into the incident determined that Butcherson appeared convinced that the firearm discharge was accidental. Consult File R5C6E8 for details on polygraph tests, fractalation effects, and possible motivations for the attack and subsequent response. Due to ongoing investigation of his role in the Event, Butcherson was declared cleared of wrongdoing and transferred, at the request of Event Specialists as well as the personal request of the injured senior director, to Field Team Delta 7, assignment: Reddington.

In spite of his long history with the Bureau, Butcherson has not been in a field or command role before, unless responsibility for several dozen lab rats is counted. Psychological testing prior to his assignment found a tendency to worry for his team and shy away from situations that could endanger them. A concerning sense of responsibility, considering his command over other potential Event Catalysts. All administrative personnel claim that his teammates' identities were not revealed to him until after testing; further analysis is recommended.

Threat Level Classification: **Extreme.** Butcherson knows more about the Bureau than any other Catalyst, and any powers he may have gained from repeated fractalation exposure are unknown and potentially deadly. Agents are advised to avoid direct confrontation. So long as he maintains his buffoonish front, interaction is safe and may help deter suspicion, but have an escape plan at all times.
